

TELESCOPE PROGRAMAIMS

- To produce new plays
- To support writers with inventive and imaginative voices
- To provide a creatively-freeing and supportive process
- To encourage rigorous research and development
- To expose the play to many minds, ears and hearts, and prompt feedback, exploration and experimentation

Telescope exists to bolster "risky" new work that writers may not be supported to create anywhere else. Today, stories need to be looked at through multiple lenses and angles. We love big ideas that investigate the world in new ways. We think creativity and ingenuity are key foundations of theatre and drama. We think that to reach modern audiences who live through modern problems, we need new perspectives, propositions and reflections.



Playwrights will receive:

- A guaranteed honorarium to write a brand new play from 2024 to 2025 (See Page 4)
- Staged readings of the play, led by a director and performed by actors
- Percentage of the box office from the staged readings
- Frequent contact with a dramaturg and regular feedback sessions
- Workshops with guest dramaturgs and associate artists
- Fully produced and coordinated by Observatory Theatre
- Tailored according to writer and project needs

Playwrights will need to be based in Queensland and be available to work in Brisbane

OBSERVATORY THEATRE

Observatory Theatre is an independent theatre company based in Brisbane. We aim to never be boring, to inspire and engage, and to provide outstanding experiences for audiences. We place big ideas and "risk taking" as a core focus of our programming. We particularly support and program Australian writing. Our previous projects include the Sci-Fi odyssey *Control* by Keziah Warner, the original musical *Destiny Doomed* by Anina-Marie van Wyk performed outdoors at Musgrave Park in South Brisbane, and the absurdist climate change comedy *The Turquoise Elephant* by Stephen Carleton. We are also focussed on developing new plays through the Telescope New Writing Program, which supports writers to produce bold and inventive work. Outcomes have included Oliver Gough's *Disney Off Ice*, an absurdist work about Walt Disney's alleged cryonic freezing.

PAYMENT AND FUNDING

Playwrights will receive a guaranteed honorarium (to be negotiated) and will be based on recommended industry rates and standards. Observatory Theatre is currently submitting applications for funding to further support writers and artists who will be involved in this program. If successful, we will re-negotiate the honorarium to offer additional remuneration.

ACCESSIBILITY

The program can be tailored for those with access needs if required. Inherent physical capabilities of this program are consistent with that of a writer or dramaturg of a theatre company. The program is designed as a combination of in-person meetings and independent/distance work.
